HERE'S WHAT THE ARTIST SAID ABOUT HER WORK

Notes from Wikipedia: Ritchie wrote of his near-death experience (NDE) in *Return from Tomorrow*, cowritten with Elizabeth Sherrill (1928-), and published in 1978. In the book he tells of his out-of-body experience,[6] his meeting with Jesus Christ,[7] and his travel with Christ through different dimensions of time and space.[8] *Return from Tomorrow* has been translated into nine languages.[9] Later he published another book, *Ordered to Return: My Life After Dying*, to elaborate on his heavenly experience.

Ritchie's story was the first contact <u>Raymond Moody</u> had with NDEs, during his post-graduate studies and residency in <u>Psychiatry</u> at the <u>University of Virginia</u>. This led Moody to investigate over 150 cases of NDEs in his book <u>Life After Life[10]</u> and two other books that followed.
